



Academic Integrity

 Academic Integrity entails carrying out original work and sharing ideas and findings of others provided that the source is cited.





Infridgements of Academic Integrity

- Plagiarism
- Cheating
- Presenting or submitting in different courses the whole or part of a personal study, homework or project done previously with a different purpose without citing the source
- Indicating sources that do not actually exist as references or creating a false data set
- Conducting academic work on behalf of other students
- Behaving in a manner so as to obtain an unfair advantage (obtaining false medical reports, declaring false excuses for period extensions and make-ups, transferring or obtaining the right of enrollment to a course in exchange for a personal gain, etc.)
- Producing or making use of fraudulent documents (reference letters, medical reports, proficiency documents/scores, transcripts, etc.)
- Impersonating someone else in an exam; having someone else impersonate oneself.





Plagiarism

- "Plagiarism is intentionally or unintentionally acquiring and using someone else's ideas and opinions and presenting them as if one's own without making a reference to or citing the source." (ODTÜ UEAM)

Plagiarism is easy to check with turnitin

This first bit is different. Brilliant example of a new originality report.

Avcademic writing in American institutions is filled with rules that writers often don't know how to follow. A working knowledge of these rules, however, is criscally important: inadvertent mistakes can lead to charges of plagiarism or the unackinowledged use of somebody else's words or ideas. While other cultures may not insist so heavily on documenting sources, American institutions do, A charge of plagiarism can have severe consequences, including expulsion from a university. This handout, which does not reflect any official university policy, is designed to help writers develop strategies for knowing how to avoid accidental plagiarism.

In college courses, we are continually engaged with other people's ideas: we read them in texts, hear them in lecture, discuss them in class, and incorporate them into our own writing. As a result, it is very important that we give credit where it is due. Plagiarism is using others' ideas and words without clearly acknowledging the source of that information.

Plagiarism Treams using another's work without giving credit. You must put others' words in quotation marks and cite your source(s) and must give citations when using others' ideas, even if those ideas are paraphrased in your own words.

to an unfortunate fact of life for University lecturers that the pressure on students leads some of them to copy other students' assignments or at least to obtain more assistance from their friends than is appropriate. Apart from discrediting the use of assignments for assessment, the copying of assignments also vibiates the assignments educational aims. The typical institutional response is to require that assignments only form a small part of a student's assessment. However, such a response is inappropriate because it either results in trivial assignments or in assignments which do not adequately repay students in marks for the effort that they have invested

Accrucial phrase in this definition is "as one's own." In all learning at University it is completely acceptable to use another person's thoughts, writings or inventions to aid our own learning and understanding, indeed, this is a primary method of learning. We all read textbooks, research papers, manuals and many other documents, and make use of the material contained in them. This is perfectly normal and acceptable.

Duvid Nightingale, the deputy vice-chancellor of Kent University said he would not comment on individual cases because the external examiners' meeting for the School of English would take place next week, when exam entries would be considered.

But he said: "I would stress that throughout their time at Kent, all students are given clear guidelines as well as practical advice and support as to what constitutes plagarium. These spell it out that it is not acceptable under any circumstances.

Course Performance Award

- Aim: To speed up the process of course completion during the graduate studies and increase student's cumGPA.
- Student should have 7 courses (21 credits)
- Student should have no unsuccessful courses
- CumGPA should be at least 3.50 (3.75 for non-thesis students)
- Student should not be unregistered or on-leave, except for Erasmus or Health reasons.
- If there are more than one student with the same highest GPA in a program, then they all get the award.





Publication Award

 Aim is to yield thesis study topics heard and used in the world of science. Support** for attending to an international congress for a report/poster presentation is given to graduate students(being admitted is sufficient) who publish an article in a foreign journal* from their theses during MSc/PhD.

*For international publications of "full paper published in a peer reviewed journal covered by SCI, SSCI, AHCI core list" type defined by the codes 1.1.1.0.1 and 1.1.1.0.2 found in the activities list entitled "Annual Performance Assessment Scheme and Minimum University requirements for an Academic Position" (ÜYK 29.02.2000 date and 2000/5-10 attachment decree)

** Those who get support for travel abroad from one of ODTÜ-ÖYP, ODTÜ-BAP, ODTÜ-YUUP, DPT during graduate education cannot apply. Nature of the awards is determined by Council of Institute Heads each year.





Thesis Award

- Aim: To contribute to the world of culture and thought in our country and to increase the research power of our country as METU.
- Given to those 16 theses (8 MSc and 8 PhD)
 - a) Which contribute to the economical, social and spatial development of the country (3 theses)
 - b) Which develop a new product or method that will contribute to human health, safety and prosperity experimentally or theoretically(4 theses)
 - c) Which contribute to the world of culture and thought in our country (3 theses)
 - d) Which integrates theory with pracatice (2 theses)
 - e) Which have the potential of international scientific publication (4 theses)
- Categories through (a)-(e), and the number of MSc and PhD theses stated for each category are recommendatory.
- Articles published in international journals or patents or reports presented at International Congresses/printed at Congress booklets or articles published in national refreed journals, or reports presented at National Congresses/printed at National Congress booklets can give theses priority.





Mustafa Parlar Thesis Award

Every year a graduate thesis is awarded by the Prof.
 Dr. Mustafa N. Parlar Foundation

 Priority is given to the thesis which produce technology.

Attending Face-to-Face Classes during the Pandemic: University Regulations



- Used to determine the deficiency and program courses you are exempt from and why.
- Enter all equivalent courses you have taken before, but...
 - No older than 10 years
 - For deficiency course equivalents, your grade should be at least
 CC if the course was an undergraduate course, CB if the course was a graduate course
 - For core course equivalents, your grade should be at least BB.
 - Read the relevant footnotes for guidance

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Important:

- (2) Courses taken more than 10 years ago cannot be used for exemption.
 (2) Grade should be greater than or equal to CC if the course was an undergraduate course, CB if the course was a graduate course. If there are two or more courses which correspond to the content of a single deficiency course, then all such courses should be entered together.
- To be formally exempt from a Deficiency course, it should be removed from the IS Bilimsel Hazırlık Formu course list.
- Grade should be greater than or equal to **BB**.
- Only equivalent courses taken from the Information Systems Department should be written.

 An additional elective course should replace a core course taken elsewhere. To be formally exempt from a core course, students should apply with a petition after finishing the Deficiency Program.
- This form should be signed only after checking the student transcripts.



Student Form 3: VERY IMPORTANT

Bilimsel Hazırlık Formu:

- Details the Deficiency Program courses you need to take and its duration based on the previous course exemption form.
- Do not change any text on the gray area.
- Delete the whole row only if you are exempt.
- Enter program courses (right column) that you plan to take while you are in the Deficiency Program – it can be updated later
- For duration, tick
 - 1 semester (1 dönem), if you are to take 1 or 2 deficiency courses
 - 2 semesters (1 yıl), if you need to take more than 2 deficiency courses
- Changes to this form is not possible after add/drops.
- At the end of the selected duration, your transcript should show the exact course code written on the left successfully taken or bye bye!!!

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Registrations – First Step

- Before registering for any course:
- Download fill in these 3 forms electronically and sign (insert your scanned signature to the relevant places)
- Get digital copies of all of your transcripts (including for programs that you have left without graduating)
- Get digital copies of syllabus of courses that you think are equivalent to our Deficiency and core courses, if they have been taken from a university other than METU
- Email all these to your advisor ASAP (ideally today)



Registrations – Second Step

- The information you have provided on these forms will be checked by your advisor.
- When your advisor agrees and signs, you will know which courses you need to take and which courses you are exempt from.





Registrations – Third Step

- Proceed to adding (registering to) courses:

- Do not panic if the course capacity is full.
 - Keep trying at different times. If it is still full and you really need to take that specific course, contact the course lecturer and/or your advisor.





Registrations – Fourth Step

- Get advisor approval
- Due to the pandemic, advisor <u>approvals will not be</u> <u>face-to-face</u>
- Once you have added your courses, click on the "Request Advisor Approval" button.
- You will be notified by email, when your advisor approves your registration.
- You will also be notified by email if your advisor requests a correction.



Important Note:

- You are in the Deficiency Program even if you need to take 1 Deficiency Course.
- You can take other Core or Elective program courses while you are in the Deficiency Program, but they need to be added with Not Included (NI) status.
- Otherwise your advisor would request a correction.
